For students who are exploring a career as journalists the class offers an opportunity to report and write news in the real world, reaching an audience that will hold them accountable

Hunts Point has plenty of both strengths and problems. Unemployment is high, residents are poor, and crime, though declining, remains a serious issue, as do asthma and other chronic health issues associated with poverty and pollution. In recent years, though, organizations like Mothers on the Move, Sustainable South Bronx and The Point community center have raised environmental awareness, fought to create parks and improve schools, and founded exciting arts and theater programs.
