The MedPrep Program is a summer enrichment program for underrepresented and disadvantaged college students interested in the medical field. Students will develop key skills and competencies important to success on the road to medical school.

How does the program work?

- ★ Enter a 6-week summer program for *3 summers* beginning June 2009
 - ★ MedPrep 1: Attend science classes, seminars, study sessions and MCAT prep-introduction
 - MedPrep 2: Clinical experience, MCAT prep-intensive
 - ★ MedPrep 3: Clinical experience, medical research and data collection
- ★ Clinical Experience
 - Receive hands-on training from a medical professional
- ★ MCAT Prep and Medical School Application Guidance
 - ★ Learn test-taking techniques
 - ☆ Participate in mock admission interviews
- ★ Research and Data Collection
 - ★ Learn various research and data collection methodologies

What are the requirements?

- ☆ Current College Freshman with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0
- ☆ Resident of New York City or New Jersey
- ☆ 3 summer commitment
