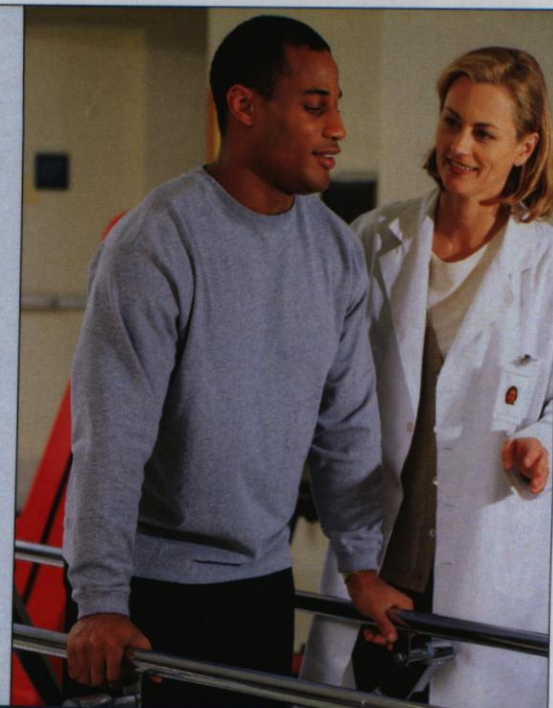


**Doctor of Physical Therapy Program
