boroughs, Long Island,  
Westchester, or New Jersey

## **How does the program work?**

Enter a summer program for **3 summers** beginning May or June annually

- ◆ MedPrep 1 (7 weeks): Attend science classes, seminars, study sessions and MCAT prep introduction
- ◆ MedPrep 2 (6 weeks): Clinical experience, MCAT prep intensive
- ◆ MedPrep 3 (6 weeks): Clinical experience, medical research and data collection

### Clinical Experience

- ◆ Receive hands-on training from a medical professional

### MCAT Prep and Medical School Application Guidance

- ◆ Learn test-taking techniques
- ◆ Participate in mock admission interviews

### Research and Data Collection

- ◆ Learn various research and data collection methodologies
