## Genetic Study of Intellectual Disabilities and Autism Spectrum Disorders



WCARP is enrolling families with children older than 12 months of age with unknown types of intellectual disabilities or autism spectrum disorders. The purpose of the study is to improve the understand behind the genetics and brain bases of autism spectrum disorders. The one time study visit includes a detailed evaluation, behavioral assessments, completion of a questionnaire, and a blood draw.

Families can be seen at our New York City, NY site. In exchange for participation, families will receive a \$25 gift certificate, a \$35 parking voucher, and free admission to a future educational symposium.
