



# Pre-doctoral and Post-doctoral Nutrition Positions Available

- The Nutrition Center at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia has post-masters, pre-doctoral and post-doctoral training positions available.
- Areas of active research include: energy metabolism, dietary intake, growth and body composition in children with chronic diseases, nutrition interventions in children with chronic diseases, bone health and osteoporosis, physical activity and obesity.
- Nutrition fellowships are available through LEND (Leadership and Education in Neurodevelopmental Disabilities and Related Disorders), an interdisciplinary training program funded by the Maternal and Child Health Bureau. LEND provides an interdisciplinary forum to address issues related to children with neurodevelopmental and other chronic diseases and promotes leadership among these professionals.

Successful candidates will be committed to a career in pediatric healthcare or research, and either hold a masters degree, be enrolled in a Ph.D. Program or hold a Ph.D. degree in Nutrition. All applicants must be either a United States citizen or permanent resident. Applications are accepted throughout the year.
