Summer Clinical Oncology Research Experience (SCORE)

The Summer Clinical Oncology Research Experience (SCORE) is an eight-week program offered to women undergraduates and post-baccalaureate students at the City College of New York and Hunter University. The goal of the program is to encourage the participation of women in clinical cancer research. **FRESHMEN ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY!**

Each student in the program will:

- Gain research experience mentored by MSKCC faculty and interacting with MSKCC staff
- Attend institutional/departmental conferences as determined by the student and her mentor.
- Participate in weekly educational lecture sessions.
- Present their summer research to SCORE peers and mentors at a seminar-style session during the final week of the program.
- Receive a \$2500 stipend

Program Dates: Monday, June 2 – Friday, July 25, 2014 (Monday – Friday, full-time)

Location: Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, 1275 York ave (between 67th and 68th street)

Eligibility: The program is open to undergraduate and post-baccalaureate women who are students at Hunter College. Freshmen and under-represented minority students are encouraged to apply.

Application Deadline: Monday, January 6, 2014, at 5:00pm (EST)
