Mr. Millett is a nationally recognized epidemiologist and researcher, and has worked at the highest levels of federal HIV policy development at both the White House Office of National AIDS Policy and the CDC. He is one of three principal writers of President Obama's National HIV/AIDS Strategy and served on the organizing committee for the 2012 International AIDS Conference. Mr. Millett worked on a diverse array of policy issues during his tenure at the White House, including the elimination of the HIV entry ban that prohibited HIV-positive persons from travelling to or seeking residency in the United States; the temporary suspension of the ban prohibiting federal funding for domestic or global needle exchange programs; and the reallocation of HIV prevention resources by CDC to adopt a new funding formula for state and local health departments that better aligns funding with current disease burden.
