The Summer Program

The Mount Sinai International Exchange Program for Minority Students invites current undergraduate, masters and doctoral degree students, and recent graduates, to conduct research as a participant in an international exchange program.

Interns will work on research projects under the guidance of prominent international scientists in Latin America, Europe, or Africa.

Students participate in a week-long orientation at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai in New York City prior to departure to their assigned countries.

Eligibility Criteria

- Underrepresented minorities in the health sciences as per the NIH definition: African American/Black, Hispanic/Latino, Indian/Native American, Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander, and rural Appalachian
- Applicants must identify as at least one of the listed minorities. No exceptions will be made.
- ◆ U.S. citizens, non-citizen nationals or permanent residents
- ◆ Enrolled in or recently graduated from BA, BS, MA, MPH, PhD, MD or other M aster's or Doctoral programs. A recent graduate is one who obtained degree within 24 months of the June 1st start date.
- ◆ Available to commit to travel for 10-12 consecutive weeks as a program participant
- Available and willing to write a research report within one month of return from international travel.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in current or most recent academic institution

Benefits

- Paid travel and housing to attend the Orientation Week in New York City
- Return flight to and housing in an international research site
- Emergency health coverage while in host country
- Monthly stipend between \$1,200—\$2,000, depending on level of training
