Frequently Asked Questions

What are CFHI "Global Health Education Programs"?

CFHI's Global Health Education Programs are also often referred to as global health internships, clinical electives, away rotations, service-learning global health scholars programs or externships. They combine exposure to clinical practices, public health, social services, social determinants of health, culture, human resources for health, and much more to provide a reflective, transformative Global Health educational experience.

How do I participate?

To participate in a CFHI Global Health Education Program:

- Choose a program location and focus that interests you.
- Choose from a variety of available start dates (see reverse) or contact CFHI at students@cfhi.org to request an alternate start date.
- Fill out a quick online application including short answer questions and 2 references.

What is included in the program fee?

The CFHI program fee includes:

Pre-Departure Support

- Guidance from CFHI staff in San Francisco before departure
- Program specific materials with information on making travel arrangements, visa requirements, recommended immunizations, etc.

On-Site Services

- Airport pick-up upon arrival and transportation with local CFHI representative to accommodations
- Welcome orientation covering safety, transportation, and other logistics
- Spanish classes (20 to 50 hours) for CFHI programs in Latin America
- CFHI Local Team: providing instruction, logistical support, and 24/7 emergency response
- Weekly meeting and lectures on local healthcare system, socioeconomic determinants of health and current cultural/historical topics
- Placement and coordination of clinical/public health activities
- Accommodation and two to three meals a day
- Local cell phone
- International emergency medical and evacuation insurance

Are there funding opportunities available?

CFHI offers partial scholarships for select program dates. All CFHI Global Health Scholars are eligible to apply for an award. Please visit our "Scholarships" page for more information. Can I get academic credit for CFHI programs?

Over 60% of CFHI Global Health Scholars receive academic credit from their school for CFHI programs. Talk to your advisor, global health, or study abroad faculty to find out what is required at your school. CFHI assists with program enrollment, confirmation letters, evaluations, and other documentation you may need. Many schools have existing agreements or partnerships with CFHI in place, which makes getting credit even easier.

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
