Students commuting should plan to arrive at NYCPC by 9:00am on July 14th for Session I and by 9:00am on August 4th for Session II.

Students should be ready to depart NYCPC at 3pm on July 16th for Session I and at 3pm on August 6th for Session II. Flights should be scheduled after 5pm to allow travel time to the LaGuardia Airport and check-in.
