Metagenomics and Metadesign of Subways and Urban Biomes (MetaSUB)



MetaSUB expands on the PathoMap project, and will be the first global, longitudinal metagenomic profile of subways and urban biomes.

The results of the PathoMap initiative have been published in *Cell Systems* and have been covered by the *Wall Street Journal* and the *New York Times*.

These subway surfaces define the commute for millions of people every single day and billions of people each year, and yet there is almost nothing known about the impact of surface type, season, commuter type, or subway design. Help us learn more!
