Position Description:

This position will be housed within the Brooklyn District Public Health Office (DPHO), in the Center for Health Equity. The Center is devoted to reducing the differences in health outcomes across the neighborhoods of New York City that can be traced to unequal economic, environmental, and social conditions. The Center promotes healthy eating, healthy living and systems changes in the food and physical environment and develops programs that promote physical activity and healthy eating.

POSITION OVERVIEW:

The Shop Healthy Program is seeking an intern to work part-time (20 hours per week) to increase access to healthy food and engage residents and organizations to support sustainable food retail change in their community. The program, launched in 2012, grew out of years of intensive work with more than 1,000 retailers in high-need communities of the city, and targets multiple types of food retailers.
