Please **read** this before you **sign up** for a particular **position**.

- There will be **1 editor** for each section. There can be **2 co-editors** for each section if two people are willing to work together. **Editors** are expected to **review** and **give suggestions** on improvements for the posts in their section before they are published. **Editors are also expected to write.**
- As **editor-in-chief**, I will be in charge of managing the blog and recruiting members. I will also contribute articles and other kinds of content to various sections on the website.
- There will be **multiple writers for each section**. Writers can post roughly **once a month** (more frequently if you post things that don't require editorial approval like things in the Fun Stuff and Careers section, and things like events and exhibitions). You might become busy at different points in the semester so you don't have to post every month.
- People can write for **multiple sections**. However, you can **only be the editor for 1 section**.
- We're not going to be very strict on how much writers have to write. **Article lengths** can be between 400 and 900 words.
- All of the sections besides "Careers" will have posts. The "**Careers**" section will have **pages**. The reason why the "Careers" section consists of pages is because it is meant to be a place where people can go to get information right away and at any time. The difference between posts and pages is that posts are put up with a date. Pages are static. **WordPress explains the difference in their "Help" pages.** (<http://learn.wordpress.com/get-published/>)
- Remember that we're trying to write in a way that students can understand, but we still want to maintain a certain level of professionalism.
