Responsibilities:

The Community Nutrition Intern will:

- Assist the registered dietitian in coordinating and implementing various community nutrition activities in a highly collaborative environment
- Facilitate community food tours to grocery stores, farmers markets, community gardens, and various other nutrition and health related community resources
- Conduct and/or facilitate nutrition education workshops in group settings
- Assist in collecting and maintaining data on program activities (e.g. administer surveys to program participants)
- Attend meetings and training as needed

Preferred qualifications:

- Current undergraduate or graduate student majoring in nutrition, public health, community health, food systems, or related field
- Knowledge and interest in urban agriculture, farmers markets, healthy cooking, food policy, community engagement and organizing, youth empowerment, food justice and/or environmental justice a major plus
- Self-starter who thrives in a team environment and motivated to address important community needs
- Good writing, speaking, and interpersonal skills
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detailed required
- Experience working with in low-income communities of color
- Bilingual English/Spanish a major plus
