Who we are

St George's, University of London is one of the oldest medical schools in the United Kingdom. With a 250-year history, its alumni include some of the founding fathers of medicine. St George's is the UK's only specialist medical and healthcare higher education institution, well known for an innovative approach to learning complemented by world-class research activity. This has earned St George's a place among the world's top 200 universities.

The University of Nicosia is the largest university in Cyprus and a global education center, representing over 80 different nations in a dynamic learning environment. It launched the country's first Medical School in 2011.

Curriculum and course structure

Graduates earn a globally recognized MBBS degree from St George's, University of London, the equivalent of an MD degree. It is considered a British primary medical qualification by the UK's General Medical Council (GMC) and is the exact same degree earned by students in London.

St George's, University of London is listed in the World Directory of Medical Schools and certified by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG). This allows graduates to obtain residencies and licensing to practice medicine in the United States or Canada.

The course is structured around problem-based learning (PBL), an active learning method that presents weekly scenarios or case histories that you explore in small groups of eight students with faculty guidance. By covering the knowledge-base required to understand different aspects of each problem, and complemented by clinical experience, traditional lectures and other learning approaches, you will acquire everything you need to practice medicine.

Students gain clinical experience from the outset, starting with community clinical attachments in Cyprus during Years 1 and 2 of the curriculum. Clinical rotations in Years 3 and 4 are at one of five international sites: Swedish Covenant Hospital in Chicago; Ponce Health Sciences University and its affiliated hospitals in Puerto Rico; Sheba Medical Center in Tel Aviv, Israel; and Nicosia or Limassol General Hospitals in Cyprus.*

The course includes test preparation for the United States Medical Licensing Exams (USMLE) and advisement on securing a residency.

* Because of visa regulations, only US and Canadian citizens are able to undertake clinical training at Swedish Covenant Hospital, while Israeli citizens are given priority for clinical training at the Sheba Medical Center

Living in Cyprus

A member of the European Union since 2004, Cyprus has an excellent quality of life. The combination of a multicultural population, modern infrastructure, rich history and a beautiful natural environment makes it an ideal place to study medicine.

Nicosia, the capital of Cyprus and the country's largest city, has something for everyone; historical sites, vibrant nightlife, continental shopping and a range of local and international cuisine. Nicosia easily connects with the rest of the country through public transportation, with beaches and mountains only a short drive away.

Admissions requirements

- A Bachelor's degree with at least a 3.0 GPA or a higher degree (e.g., MA, PhD) in any discipline
- A satisfactory score in the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) or Graduate Australian Medical School Admission Test (GAMSAT)
- A personal interview by video

Tuition, fees and living costs

Annual tuition and fees are €27,500 (around US \$30,000). Living costs of course depend on your lifestyle. On average, staying in Nicosia for the whole year will cost a minimum of €9,000 (or US \$9,500).

Financial assistance

Scholarships are available to help eligible students partially fund their studies. These are based on either academic excellence or demonstrated financial need and will not exceed 30% of tuition costs per year.

The St George's, University of London Medical Program at the University of Nicosia is approved for Sallie Mae® loans. Canadian students are able to use the Canada Student Loans Program to finance our medical program.
