Objectives

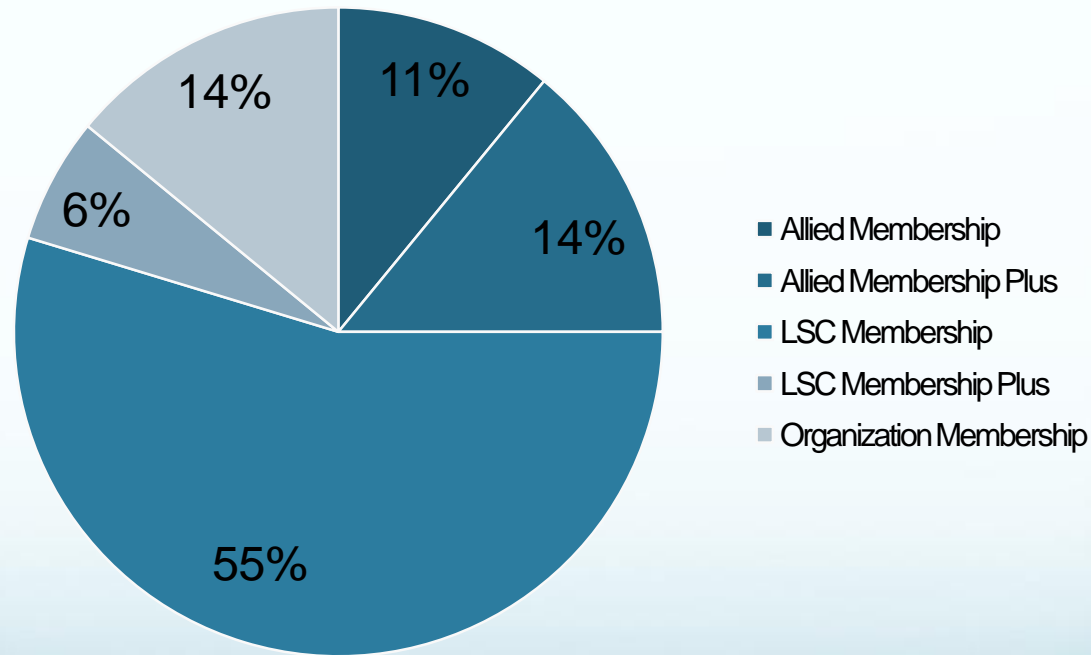
- Develop NAPPLSC Mentorship Program

- Utilize Committees to develop and implement NAPPLSC initiatives

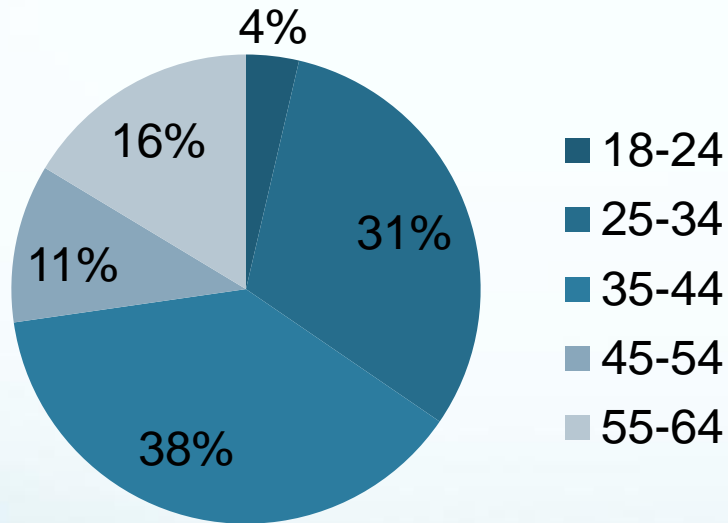

Membership Levels

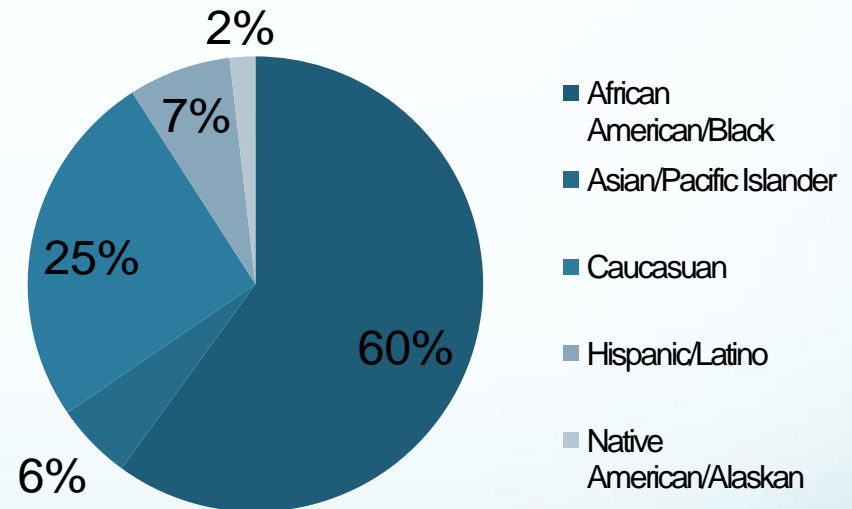


Membership Stats

Race/Ethnicity

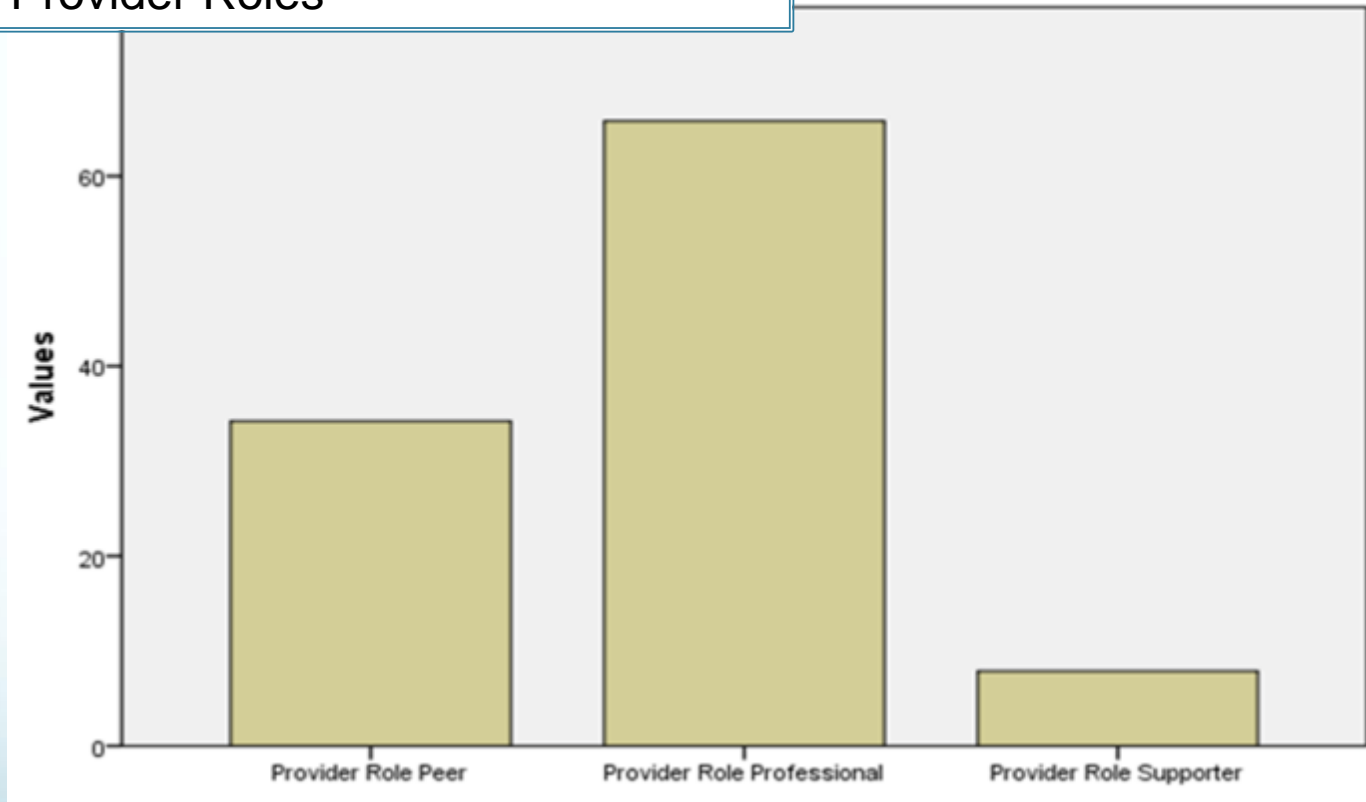

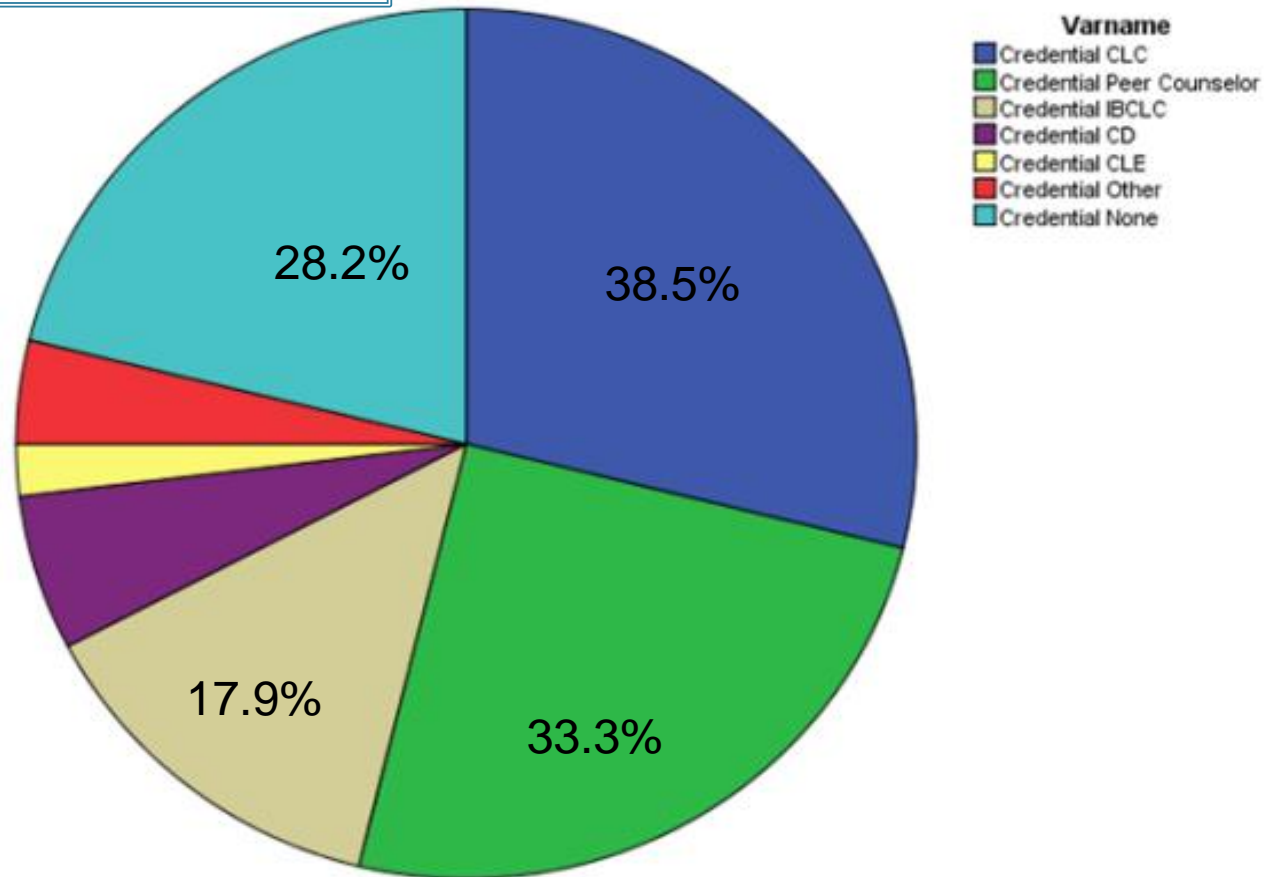

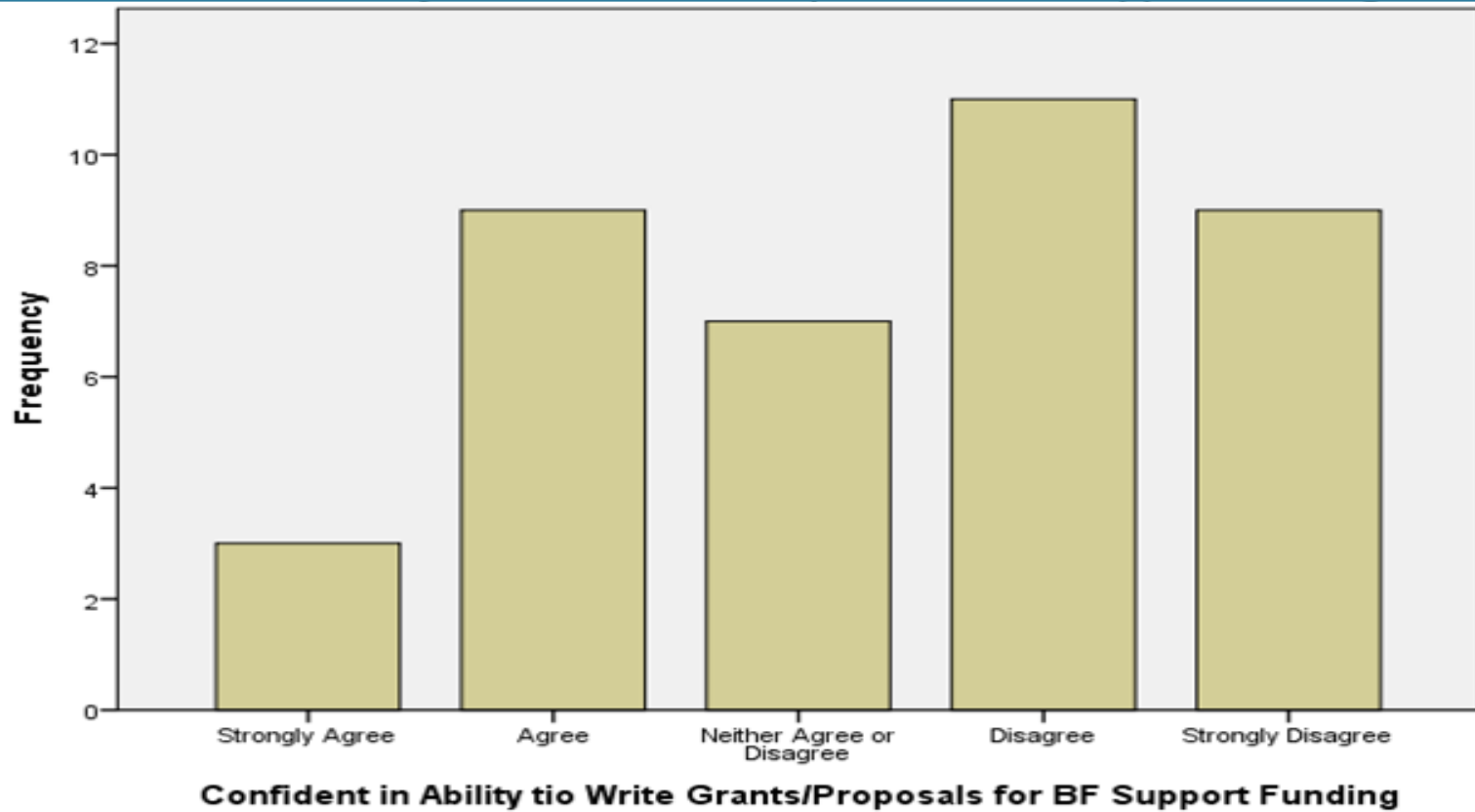
There are barriers to professional development within the field of lactation



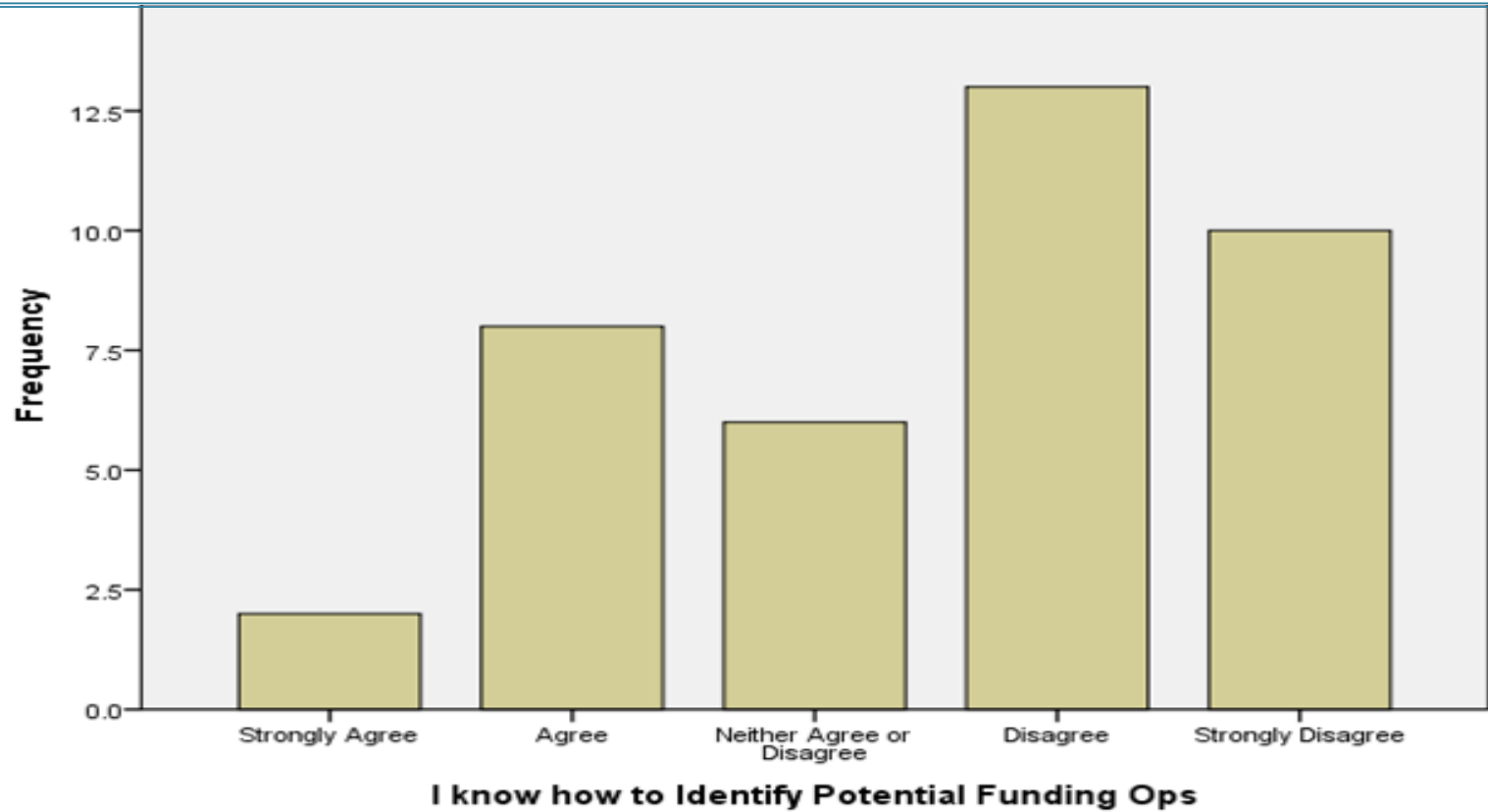
In healthcare communities of color receive the same level of breastfeeding education and support as their counterparts



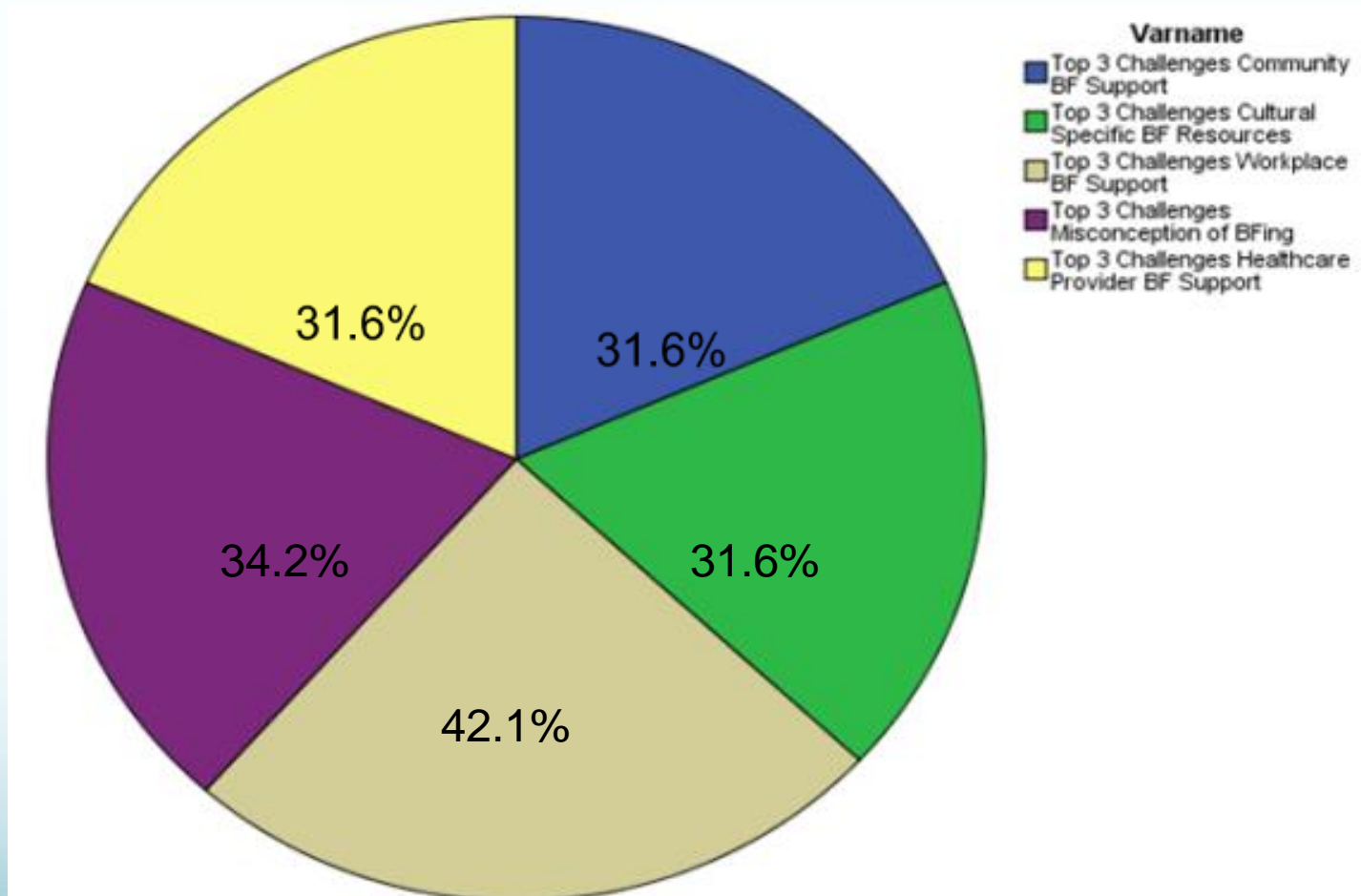
I feel confident in my ability to write grants and/or proposals to obtain funds and resources needed to effectively provide breastfeeding support to my community
