



# Undergraduate Research Program

#### Program Overview

Greetings! The Hansjörg Wyss Department of Plastic Surgery at NYU Langone Medical Center & Department of Biomaterials & Biomimetics at the NYU School of Dentistry invite you to apply for a position as an undergraduate research associate. This is an exciting new program intended for CUNY students achieving academic excellence to develop a strong research background.

#### **Program Description**

This program is intended to prepare undergraduates for a career as a clinician-scientist by providing the opportunity to participate in a premier research experience offered at the one of the largest translational surgical laboratories in the country, here at NYU.

Students will conduct cutting-edge translational research in the fields of bone regeneration and surgical hardware optimization with technologies including, but not limited to: 3D printing, microCT imaging, nanoindentation, and histological analysis software. The duration of this program is one academic year. Students will be expected to function at the level of research associate, and will be expected to contribute extensively to experiments, attend laboratory meetings, and give a research presentation prior to culmination of the research year. Academic credit for independent study may be possible as well.

## **Application Requirements**

- Applicants must be from Baruch College, or another CUNY institution
- Applicants must:
  - Complete the application form
  - Provide a one-page personal statement discussing career objectives
  - Provide one letter of recommendation from a science faculty member
  - Provide curriculum vitae
  - Provide a school transcript (unofficial transcript is acceptable)
- Applications will be reviewed by the program coordinator, lab director, and Principal Investigator, and based on this review, students will be invited for an interview
