- A baccalaureate degree or equivalent from

- Completion of a Didactic Program in Dietetics
 (DPD) accredited by the Accreditation Council for
 Education of Nutrition & Dietetics with coursework
 completed within the last 10 years
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale with a minimum grade of "C" in prerequisite DPD, mathematics, and science coursework
- Dietetic-related volunteer and work experience in the fields of nutrition, food science, health, laboratory or clinical research, foodservice, food industry, nutrition education, or health promotion
- 5. Submission of GRE scores
- Minimum TOEFL iBT score of 80 with a minimum score of 20 in each exam sub-section (international students only)
- Submission of the online College of Graduate Studies and Dietetic Internship applications and fees

THE DIETETIC INTERNSHIP AT GEORGIA SOUTHERN

The Georgia Southern Dietetic Internship (DI) is a full-time, 12-month, post-baccalaureate graduate certificate non-degree dietetic internship program, with concentrations in community nutrition and school nutrition. The program prepares students to become successful entry-level registered dietitians who embrace the values of integrity, collaboration, commitment to lifelong learning, wellness and social responsibility.

The Georgia Southern Dietetic Internship offers 13 credit hours of graduate coursework and 1,200 hours of supervised practice experiences designed to meet ACEND Core Competencies for the registered dietitian (RD).

Graduates of a Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD) are eligible to apply to the Georgia Southern Dietetic Internship. A maximum of 20 interns are admitted annually to the Georgia Southern Dietetic Internship: 10 in the Community Nutrition concentration and 10 in the School Nutrition concentration.

Upon successful completion of the DI, interns are eligible to sit for the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR) registration examination for dietitians.
