- **Cardiovascular Perfusion, BS** pumping or oxygenating blood, temporarily replacing the work of the heart or lungs
- **Medical Biotechnology BS** conducting medical research in academic or industry settings
- **Medical Technology BS** performing lab tests to diagnose and monitor disease
- **Medical Imaging/Radiology, BS, BPS** taking X-rays, CTs and MRIs to diagnose injury or disease
- **Nursing, BS, MS, DNP** programs for registered nurses
- **Radiation Therapy, BS, BPS** treating cancer patients with radiation
- **Respiratory Therapy, BS** assisting people who have difficulty breathing
- **Ultrasound, BS, BPS** creating ultrasound images

- **Medical Technology, MS** performing lab tests to diagnose and monitor disease
- **Medicine, MD MD/PhD, MD/MPH** programs for physicians
- **Physician Assistant, MS** practicing medicine with a doctor's supervision
